## Association of Owners of Kalele Kai Pet Rules

### **Please keep this for your information**

Kalele Kai is a pet-friendly community. As such, these are the rules of conduct and responsibility for pet owners.

1. A household may have a maximum of two dogs or cats less than 30 pounds in weight or a reasonable number of other generally recognized household pets which are caged or confined as part of its normal maintenance such as, but not limited to, birds, fish and turtles. No pet shall be kept or bred for any commercial purpose. No livestock, chicken, pigs or farm animals whatsoever shall be allowed or kept in any part of the Project. (Association Bylaws, Section 6.2.n)

2. The Resident Manager has the authority to require a dog or cat to be weighed by a designated veterinary clinic, the cost of which shall be paid by the owner if the pet is determined to be over the weight limit. Pets that exceed 30 pounds shall be removed.

3. All cats over 6 months of age shall have identification worn by the cat. (Revised Ordinances of the City and County of Honolulu (ROH), Section 7-6.2)

4. All dogs over 4 months of age shall be registered with the City & County of Honolulu biennially. (ROH, Section 7-3.1)

5. All dogs shall be under control of the owner by leash, cord, chain or other similar means of physical restraint; provided, that such leash, cord, chain or other means is not more than eight feet in length. (ROH, Section 7-4.1)

6. No pets are allowed within the Pool and Cabana area.

7. Certified guide animals may be used by physically disabled residents and guests at any time. The pet weight and access restrictions set forth herein shall not apply to certified guide animals.

8. If any pet or certified guide animal or other animal causes a nuisance or unreasonable disturbance or presents a danger to any person, its owner shall be given the opportunity to rectify the problem. If the problem persists, the Board can require the removal of animals that present any unreasonable risk to persons or property.

9. It is a violation to allow your pet to be unescorted or unleashed outside of your apartment at anytime. Special care should be taken while indoors, meaning the interior common areas of our buildings (hallways, lobby, elevators, stairwells and garages) as well as the outdoor grounds of our Project. The only exception to this leash rule is within the designated Dog Run.

10. Pet owners shall only allow their pets to urinate and defecate outdoors and shall promptly clean up the defecation after their pets. Under no circumstances shall pets be allowed to urinate or defecate inside our buildings. Pet owners must either carry their pet in a cart, in their arms, or hold the pet by a short leash while indoors anywhere on the common elements. In the event of an accident, owners please immediately clean up after their pet. Parents shall be responsible for violations by children attending their pets.

11. All dogs, pets and service animals, are required to pay a \$50 administrative fee to the Kalele Kai Management Office and have their dog submit a sample of their DNA (saliva sample) to the PooPrints program to be listed in the Kalele Kai registry. The \$50 fee covers the cost of the initial registration with PooPrints.

12. If dog waste is found on property unattended and management is able to determine who the waste is from through DNA testing, the unit responsible for the pet/service animal shall be assessed the following:

1st offense - \$80 (cost of DNA test) plus a written warning

2nd offense - \$130 (cost of DNA test plus \$50 fine) plus a citation

3rd offense - \$180 (cost of DNA test plus \$100 fine) plus a citation and removal of pet from property
